These 2 second-appeals have been filed by Shri D.K. Chopra (appellant). The information requested by the appellant are reproduced below:-

Appeal No.CIC/AT/A/2007/00997:

RTI-application dated 15.2.2007:

- “1. *Number of cases pending against Shri D.K. Chopra, Superintendent Customs Preventive Legal Branch.*
2. *Please supply the list of such cases and their position.*
3. *These cases are pending for his murder by poisoning or his dismissal by other means.*
4. *The department had given permission to the police number of times without verifying the facts of the cases of arrest Shri D.K. Chopra. In one case on 11 April 2002 department gave permission to Shri Om Parkesh SI Delhi Police with a condition to bring his daughter for prostitution. Is the department running a side business other than collect government revenues? Is this British system still exist, Please Quote the authority?*
5. *Since April 19, 2001 the departmental officers poisoned Shri D.K. Chopra in side the office premises number of times and outside the office by accident attempts including spoiling the scooter and fixing remote in it. Please quote the authority or ruling.”*

Appeal No.CIC/AT/2007/00998:

RTI-application dated 17.2.2007:

- “1. *How many Class I (Group A) and B,C, & D officer died on duty since 1975. Please supply the name of officers and their dependents name that jobs are given.*
2. *Any enquiry was conducted or reasons for their death were called for.”*

2. Parties were called for a hearing on 20.12.2007. The appellant was present in person, while the respondents were represented by Shri S.K. Bhaskar, Assistant Commissioner.

3. Even a cursory look at these appeals leaves one in no doubt about these being frivolous, vexatious, non-serious and serving no public interest whatsoever.

4. The appellant has wasted the time of officers from the CPIO upwards to the Commission for something which must be summarily dismissed. In fact, replying to some of his queries would amount to self-incrimination of a very serious kind. The RTI-regime can surely do without such protagonists.

5. Considering the fact that no information can be supplied relevant to the appellant's queries, it is held that there shall be no disclosure obligation as regards these two appeals.

6. The appeals are rejected.
